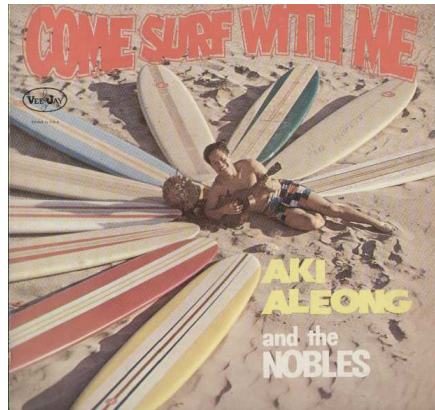

Not much piano or anything that connects Leon with this session. On “Apache” is an instrument that sounds like a harpsichord or electric piano, and on “Hiawatha” is three or so runs on the ivories that certainly could be Leon – apart from that – just another surf-instrumental.

The surf guitar is not bad though! Aleong was and is a well known actor in movies and TV-series.
